In order for your application to be considered for any scholarships, you must complete the CSUSA all the way through to the Confirmation Page at the end of the application. Once you are on the Confirmation Page, select *Save/Submit This Information, Then Continue to the Next Page* from the drop-down menu at the bottom of the page and then click on *Enter*.

On the Confirmation Page, your answers to the questions may not appear to have the same layout and formatting you entered. However, the formatting has been saved and will look accurate when your scholarship application is reviewed by the scholarship committees.
